Mare Management Fee: (non-refundable) payable to Parker Farms \$350

1. The Mare Management Contract must be completed, signed and filed before moving forward with the breeding procedure at Parker Farms.
2. All other expenses, including board, veterinary expenses, farrier fees, etc. will be due upon receipt of monthly statement. All fees shall be paid in full prior to the mare's departure from the breeding facility. 18% interest will be charged on all accounts in excess of thirty days.
3. **ALL ARRIVING MARES *MUST* HAVE A CURRENT HEALTH CERTIFICATE, CURRENT NEGATIVE COGGINS TEST AND *MUST* BE CURRENT ON *ALL* VACCINATIONS.**

Vaccinations shall be administered a minimum of 14 days prior to arrival. A maximum of 90 days is required for: Influenza (flu), Rhinoneumonitis (rhino), Tetanus, Eastern/Western Encephalomyelitis (EEE & WEE), Streptococcus Equi (strangles) and West Nile.

These vaccinations *must* be shown on health certificate. This is mandatory for the safety of all mares and foals on the premises.

4. A copy of the mare's registration papers must be returned with this contract.
5. If mare is being bred to a stallion not standing at Parker Farms, a copy of the breeding contract for that mare/stallion is required with the execution of this contract.
6. The breeding season begins February 1st and close on June 30th.

Mare owners agree to leave the mare at Parker Farms until the mare reaches a 35-day positive pregnancy exam or as otherwise, agreed by both parties. If however, the mare does not become pregnant, the Mare Owner will not hold the Stallion Owner, Parker Farms, and/or their representatives liable.

7. *Waiver of Liability:* Parker Farms, nor their agents, employees, officers, directors, Veterinarians or guests shall not be held liable and shall be released and held harmless from any and all claims, causes of actions, expenses and damages of any nature resulting from or relating to any escape, accident, injury, sickness, disability and/or death of mare and/or foal as well as any exercises of judgment by the released parties in connection with the custody and care of the mare and/or foal.
8. *Litigation:* Any litigation that may result from this Contract must solely take place in Robeson County, North Carolina. Mare Owners must irrevocably and unconditionally submit to the personal and subject matter jurisdiction of North Carolina. All objections as to venue are waived.
9. *Liquidated Damages:* Should any dispute arise that is not otherwise governed or covered by a provision in this Breeding Contract, including but not limited to, a dispute alleging Breeder has breached this Breeding Contract, the Parties hereby specifically agree that damages, expenses, costs, and fees, including attorney's fees for such dispute, whatever the nature of the dispute, shall be limited to the sum of \$2500.00
10. *Contract:* This Contract represents the entire agreement between the parties. No other agreements or promises, verbal or implied, are included unless specifically stated in this written Contract. The parties must individually initial additional agreements. When Mare Owner and Breeder sign this Contract, it will be binding on both parties, subject to the above terms and conditions.
